Pressure Activated Switch

Please Note:

For your safety, this product is equipped with a pressure activated switch to control the heat function. Heat will not operate unless pressure is applied to this switch. located on the seat bottom of the unit. Once pressure is removed, heat will turn off. After applying pressure, please allow 5-10 minutes for heat to reach maximum temperature.

- This unit is not a toy. Children should not use it or play with it.
- Never use while sleeping.
- Do not place or store appliance where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink.
- Do not place or drop into water or any other liquid.
- Never reach for an appliance that has fallen into water. Unplug it immediately.
- This appliance should never be left unattended when plugged in. Unplug from outlet when not in use.
- Never operate this appliance if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, if it has been dropped or damaged or dropped into water. Return it to the HoMedics Service Center for examination and repair.

Instructions for Use

For Use in Home or Office

Plug adapter into a 120 volt AC outlet and plug the receptacle end into the input jack, located along the side of the cushion. Attach Back Therapist to your chair for a luxurious massage as you read, rest or even work.

For Use in Your Car

Simply plug the 12 volt auto adapter into a cigarette outlet and plug the receptacle end into the input jack, located along the side of the cushion. Slip Back Therapist's straps over your seat to enjoy a relaxing massage as you drive.

Back Therapist incorporates a unique strapping system which allows you to fasten it to most any chair or auto seat. Just slip the straps over the seat or chair and adust the convenient hooks to fit. Your massager won't slip or slide away.

Maintenance

To Store Place massager in its box or a safe, dry, cool place. Avoid contact with sharp edges or pointed objects which might cut or puncture the fabric surface. To avoid breakage, do not wrap the power cord around the unit. Do not hang the unit by the controller cord.

To Clean Unplug the unit and allow it to cool before cleaning. Clean only with a soft, slightly damp sponge. Never allow water or any other liquids to come into contact with the unit.

- Do not immerse in any liquid to clean.
- Never use abrasive cleaners, brushes, gasoline, kerosene, glass/furniture polish, paint thinner to clean.
- Do not attempt to repair Back Therapist massager. There are no user serviceable parts. For service, send the unit to the HoMedics address listed in the warranty section.

On/Off — Massage Strength

Before connecting power source, be sure ON/OFF controls are in the OFF position. Back Therapist gives you three options of massage strengths: low (L), medium (M) and high (H). To change the strength of your massage, simply slide the button to the corresponding position.

Power Adapters

Back Therapist is powered by a custom 120 volt AC home adapter, and 12 volt DC auto adapter (cigarette lighter plug-in style). Both are included with your unit.

Targeted Massage Buttons

Zone buttons activate motors to massage specific areas: shoulders, back and thighs. Customize your massage by choosing one specific area or any combination of areas. To select a massage area, simply slide the button to the right and the corresponding L.E.D. light will illuminate. To deselect, simply slide the button to the left and the corresponding L.E.D. light will turn off.



- Heat

Soothing, penetrating heat in the lower back region is activated by sliding this button to the right.

Note: When selecting the heat feature with massage action, there will be a slight decrease in the strength of the massage output. This adjustment is perfectly normal and should not be interpreted as a defect.
